

Shoe Care

• GENERAL CARE

Water Damage

Fill wet shoes with tissue paper or newspaper and let them air dry. Do not dry shoes directly against a heat source.

Heels

Regularly check on the tips of the heels to ensure they are not worn down. If they are, consider adding a rubber cap.

Other General Tips

- Avoid direct light and heat sources. It is best to let the shoes dry naturally.
- Alternate shoes.
- Fill shoes with tissue paper or newspaper when not in use.
- Let shoes air dry before putting them in the closet.

• MATERIALS CARE

Smooth Leather

Nappa - high quality lambskin, calf, kid - high quality goatskin

Treat with a suitable spray or neutral creamy product. Remove dirt with a soft, slightly dampened cloth. Store shoes to avoid direct light and heat sources.

Patent leather - shiny finish, glossy

Gently rubbing the shoe with a soft flannel cloth can remove most stains. For stains that cannot be easily removed, clean shoes with patent leather cleaner. Do not use household cleaners. Keep patent leather separate from other patent leathers and plastic.

Embossed leathers

Clean with a dry sponge or soft cloth, and a light hand. The embossed or metal film makes the product surface delicate. Store shoes to avoid direct light and heat sources.

Suede and Nubuck

Treat with an appropriate protector that protects against stains and water damage before use. Use a suede brush or nubuck eraser to remove dirt. Regularly brush to keep the nap raised. Sprinkle talcum powder on oil stains immediately. Fill shoes with tissue paper or newspaper when not in use.

Pony - hair calf

A complex tanning process is used to produce this leather. Clean with a slightly damp brush, following the direction of the fur. Use a soft cloth to dry the fur. Store shoes to avoid direct light and heat sources.
